

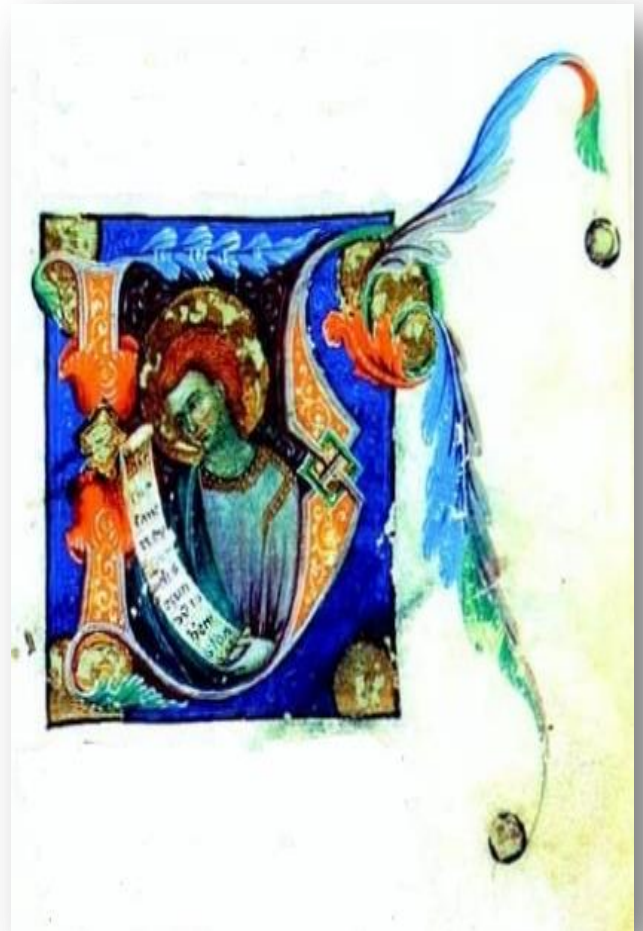


# THIRD MEDIEVAL WORKSHOP IN RIJEKA

**CALL FOR PAPERS**

**Department of History of Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences at the University of Rijeka** in collaboration with the **Department of Historical Research of the Institute of Historical and Social Sciences of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts in Zagreb** are pleased to invite proposals to the “**Third medieval workshop**” in Rijeka.

The Workshop is planned as a gathering of young medievalists at the early stages of their career, doctoral and postdoctoral students. Workshop follows upon the previous ones, which makes this an opportunity for further networking and presentation of research within the community of medievalists. The Workshop will be held at the **Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Rijeka (University Campus at Trsat) on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2015.**

The Workshop is divided in two segments. The first part is reserved for presenting current research, while the emphasis of the second part will be placed on thematic workshops based on a specific field in medieval research. The co-located workshops are intended to provide a forum for researchers to address and exchange positions on the wide span of topics. These thematic workshops will be led by Croatian and international scholars - experts in the aforementioned fields. General intention is to present new methodologies in the research of various aspects of Middle Ages.

How to apply:

**1. Individual papers:**

Speakers are asked to submit the title of the presentation and a short abstract (up to 500 words). Upon the acceptance the organizers assort the presentation within thematically related session and provide a moderator.

**2. Thematic session:**

Several speakers can, according to their interests, organize and submit a session. The application must contain the title of the session, names of each speaker, titles of each presentation and short abstracts for every paper (up to 500 words). For the thematic sessions the organisers can provide moderators, but session organisers also have the option to choose their own moderator.

For the second part of the congress there is no need to apply in advance for thematic workshops, as the attendance is open to all participants.
